PROPOSED OUTLINE FOR AN AGRICULTURE TRAINEESHIP

SCHOOL BASED AND NON SCHOOL BASED

Students undertaking a Agriculture Traineeship can expect to attend a number of group trainings with RST (from the list outlined below); and have 'electives' signed off by a supervisor/assessor or employer to confirm their competence in performing tasks.

RST FACE TO FACE TRAININGS

CORE Block Release

- Workplace OH&S procedures
- Work effectively in the industry
- Participate in workplace communication
- Observe environmental work practices

FIRST AID Block Release

- Apply first aid (Senior First Aid certificate)

RECORD KEEPING Block Release

- Keep records for the small business
- Create and use simple spreadsheets

CHAINSAW Block Release

- Chainsaw 'Ticket'

WORKING DOGS Block Release

- Care for and train working dogs

STOCK STRUCTURE AND NUTRITION Block Release

- Comply with industry animal welfare requirements
- Implement feeding plans for livestock

EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND FIRE SAFETY Block Release

- Prevent injury
- Respond to wildfire
- Use portable fire fighting equipment

CROP AGRONOMY Block Release

- Control plant pests, diseases and disorders

CHEMICAL ACCREDITATION Block Release

- Full Chemical Accreditation Certificate

Other possible trainings may include welding and machinery maintenance.

ELECTIVE REQUIREMENTS

Trainees will need to complete approximately 6–10 electives depending on which course they are doing. These can be selected according to the trainees' interests and/or the work they will be doing on the job. The electives can be assessed and signed off by a supervisor as the trainee develops the skills to complete the required tasks. Electives could consist of any of the following examples or any of the units from the Rural Production Training Package:

RTE2011A	Assist agricultural crop establishment
RTE2030A	Assist agricultural crop harvesting
RTE2110A	Maintain livestock water supplies
RTE2115A	Muster and move livestock
RTE2130A	Ride horses and care for equipment
RTE2129A	Move and handle pigs
RTE3101A	Artificially inseminate livestock
RTE3113A	Identify and draft livestock
RTE3810A	Provide advice on livestock products
RTE3819A	Process customer complaints
BSBCMN307A	Maintain business resources
BSBEBUS302A	Use and maintain electronic mail system

We work with employers to determine the most suitable training plan for trainees however all students are required to attend the compulsory 'Core' units, Senior First Aid, and generic Block Releases applicable to their qualification.

SACE POINTS

School based trainees earn SACE points while gaining a nationally recognised qualification.
