PROPOSED OUTLINE FOR A PRODUCTION HORTICULTURE TRAINEESHIP

SCHOOL BASED AND NON SCHOOL BASED

Students undertaking a Production Horticulture Traineeship can expect to attend a number of group trainings with RST (from the list outlined below); and have 'electives' signed off by a supervisor/assessor to confirm their competence in performing tasks.

RST FACE TO FACE TRAININGS

CORE Block Release

- Workplace OH&S procedures
- Work effectively in the industry
- Participate in workplace communication
- Observe environmental work practices

FIRST AID Block Release

- Apply first aid (Senior First Aid certificate)

RECORD KEEPING Block Release

- Keep records for the small business
- Create and use simple spreadsheets

CHAINSAW Block Release

- Chainsaw 'Ticket'

EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND FIRE SAFETY Block Release

- Prevent injury
- Respond to wildfire
- Use portable fire fighting equipment

CHEMICAL ACCREDITATION Block Release

- Full Chemical Accreditation Certificate

Other possible trainings may include welding and machinery maintenance.

RST WORKS WITH YOU TO ENSURE TRAINING MEETS YOUR NEEDS

ELECTIVE REQUIREMENTS

Trainees will need to complete approximately 6-10 electives depending on the course they are doing. These can be selected according to the trainees' interests and/or the work they will be doing on the job. The electives can be assessed and signed off by a supervisor as appropriate once the trainee can perform the required tasks. Electives could consist of any of the following examples or any of the units from the Rural Production Training Package:

RTC2309A	Operate tractors
RTE2010A	Establish horticultural crops
RTE2021A	Support horticultural crop harvesting
RTE2602A	Assist with the operation of pressurised irrigation systems
RTE2902A	Collect and record production data
RTC3404A	Control plant pests, diseases and disorders
RTE3030A	Harvest horticultural crops mechanically
RTE3012A	Implement a plant nutrition program
RTF3014A	Implement a propagation plan
BSBCMN307A	Maintain business resources
BSBCMN308A	Maintain financial records
BSBEBUS302A	Use and maintain electronic mail system

FLEXIBILITY

We work with employers to determine the most suitable training plan for trainees, however all students are required to attend the compulsory 'Core units', Senior First Aid and the generic trainings applicable to their qualification.

SACE POINTS

School based trainees earn SACE points while gaining a nationally recognised qualification.
